The following information will assist you as you arrive:

- The conference will be held in the Pigott Building on the Seattle University Campus. The main campus entrance is located at 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue & E. Marion Street; the Pigott Building will be directly in front of you as you pass the security guard booth.
- A self-serve parking lot is located directly to the right of the security guard booth and across from the Pigott Building. If parking is full, the Murphy Parking Garage is located on the corner of 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue & E. Cherry Street, 2 blocks south of the main entrance.
- On your arrival, you will check in at the registration table located in the lobby. At that time you will receive conference materials, a map of the campus, and other information.
- A *Presenters Table* will be available next to the conference check-in table. Please feel free to leave handouts, resource materials, business cards, etc. on the *Presenters Table* for attendees who miss your presentation or need copies.
- Each conference room is equipped with an audio/visual station which includes the use of a Windows based computer, LDC projector, and DVD/VHS player. You may bring your presentation on a flash drive or CD to use at the station. Conference rooms are classroom style with full wipe boards.
- The Seattle Indian Health Board will shuttle a van to/from the Renaissance Hotel on 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue and the conference.
