#### All Services Are Free!

**Dental:** fillings, extractions, x-rays, deep cleanings

**Vision:** eye exams, glaucoma screenings, diabetic retinopathy, prescription glasses (to skip exam, bring a current eyeglasses prescription, not older than 1 year)

**Medical:** physical exams, PAP smears, x-rays, EKGs, mammograms, ultrasounds, foot care, wound care, select lab tests, behavioral health, immunizations, acupuncture, naturopathic & chiropractic care, physical therapy consultation, nutrition and pharmacy counseling.
