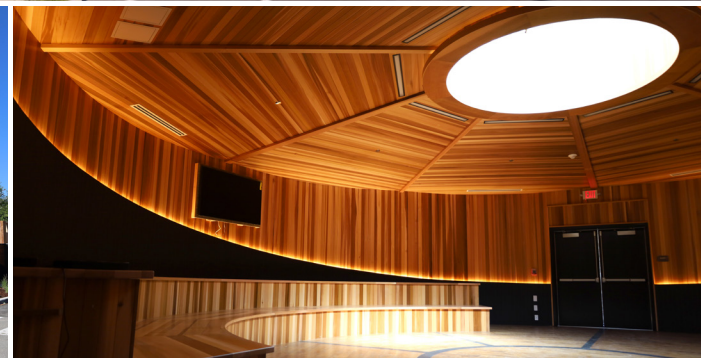




Thunderbird Treatment Center

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Thunderbird blends innovative therapies with personalized treatment plans, tailored to each individual's unique needs and goals. Thunderbird's inpatient program is grounded in culturally based healing, drawing on the teachings of the Red Road to Wellbriety that supports a balanced life rooted in respect for self, others, and creation. Guided by White Bison's integration of the Medicine Wheel and an American Indian and Alaska Native perspective that mirrors the 12-Step model, the program offers a holistic path to healing for individuals and families that connects traditional values and community.

Residents will have access to:

- Behavioral health professionals
- Individual and group counseling
- Traditional Indian Medicine professionals
- Outdoor activities
- Programming for pregnant or parenting adults
- Ancillary comprehensive services, including psychiatry, Medication-Assisted Treatment, dental, pharmacy, primary care, and an array of human services
